

MANCHESTER COWHIDE

PRODUCT CHARACTERISTIC SHEET



NECK/FAT WRINKLES

A: Permanent natural creases on the hide caused by fat deposits in the live animal usually found in the neck, shoulder, and belly area.

VARIATION IN DISTRESSING EFFECT

B: Throughout the hide, the distressing effect will vary. Some areas will be more heavily distressed than others.

VISIBLE BACKBONE

C: Inconsistent grain found in the center of the hide running along the entire length of the hide.

SCARS

D: Healed wound during life of animal which is characterized by raised surface and inconsistent grain.

VEINS

E: Characterized by many clearly visible blood vessels, either closed or cut open by splitting or shaving operations.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Manchester Cowhide is aniline-dyed cowhide with a wax finish and a clear protective topcoat. The leather surface is burnished to highlight the natural look and variation of each hide. A final glaze is applied to provide additional protection and to create a polished look.

CHARACTERISTICS:

Natural variations in color, tone and texture are part of the beauty of this leather artwork and highlight each hide's unique history and natural markings

Each hide's natural markings will be highlighted. The appearance of natural markings such as the backbone, healed scars, and fat wrinkles are to be expected. This is a very natural leather; the leather itself has only been minimally altered from its natural state.

COLOR VARIATION

F: As an Aniline leather, there will be natural variation in color shading within a hide and from hide to hide.
